GRANTS RECEIVED

AMONG THE AGENCIES

FLORENCE M. MULLER FOUNDATION

A \$45,000 grant was awarded to CP Rochester towards Family Dental Center operations.

DASNY NONPROFIT INFRASTRUCTURE CAPITAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (NICIP)

\$181,486 was awarded to Rochester Rehabilitation Center for renovations at the University Avenue location.

OFFICE OF PEOPLE WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES (OPWDD)

Happiness House was awarded \$831,621 and CP Rochester was awarded \$864,765 to help fund Family Support Services for each agency.

MARILYN LICTMAN FOUNDATION

CP Rochester's Family Dental Center was awarded \$25,000.

Happiness House was awarded \$4,081 to purchase a SmartBoard for the Geneva preschool's Blue Room. CP Rochester was awarded \$7,826.40 to update the ceiling lift and track system in the locker room at the Winton site.

\$6,654.74 was awarded to the CP Rochester Dental Center to purchase dental equipment.

RCIPA

CP Rochester's Family Dental Center was awarded \$25.000.

MARY CLARK THOMPSON

\$1,609 was awarded to Happiness House to purchase an AED machine for the Canandaigua site.



GRANTS AWARDED

ABILITY PARTNERS FOUNDATION AWARDED OVER \$30K TO ABILITY PARTNERS AGENCIES IN INTERNAL GRANTS IN 2025

CP ROCHESTER

- The Clinic was awarded \$1,425 to purchase a laptop, computer cart, iPad, keyboard, monitor, cables, and mice to improve their point of service documentation equipment; \$1,800 to reupholster physical therapy mats on tables; \$400 to replace clinic stools.
- The Residential Program was awarded \$3,000 for new living room furniture at Elmwood Avenue.
- Day Habilitation received a grant of \$575 to purchase
 Sensory Zen items to enhance the workshop-created table for individuals with dementia and Alzheimer's.
- SportsNet was awarded \$2,550 for golf cart batteries & equipment upgrades; \$250 to replace aquatic equipment.

HAPPINESS HOUSE

- Maple Avenue was awarded \$500 to invite friends & family over to celebrate the holiday season.
- Canandaigua Preschool's Blue Room was awarded \$310 to purchase carpet circles & flooring for classroom activities; the Yellow Room received \$805 to upgrade their cabinets.
- \$2,010 was awarded to preschool staff for the purchase of Gross Motor Equipment that helps children of all abilities meet their goals and objectives; \$1,680 was awarded to the children's department for temporal scanners at each location; \$1,645 was received to adjust the playground's accessibility.
- Canandaigua clinic received \$2,000 to update their waiting area furniture and purchase new desk chairs for the staff.
- The Lochland School clinic location was awarded \$950 to purchase TheraBands, cuff weights, an OT table, chairs & stools.

ROCHESTER REHABILITATION CENTER

- OneSource Solutions was awarded \$3,820 to purchase a semielectric straddle stacker for the production floor & \$2,100 for a commercial air scrubber.
- \$850 to update medical equipment for providers in the Mental Health Outpatient & Rehabilitative Services Program and to pass out COVID tests to consumers; the Mental Health Clinic was awarded \$1,400 for waiting room enhancements.
- \$510 was awarded to assist families & individuals during the holiday season.
- University Avenue was awarded \$1,500 to purchase a refrigerator and microwave for the employee breakroom

In January, he was able to complete a work experience at Unity Hospital in the Food Service Department leading to his current position as a Food Service Associate. Through perseverance, Nicholas has not only secured and maintained employment but has also achieved a significant milestone: saving enough to move into his own apartment. These partnerships prove that opportunity is one of the most powerful tools for change.

Maria has grown up with our agencies, from living at Happiness House's children's IRA to now thriving in a CP Rochester adult IRA while attending Day Habilitation. Along the way, she's built independence and confidence, while also giving back as a volunteer in the Augustin Children's Program classrooms. This year, she reached a new milestone: acceptance into the B.E.L.L. college program through our partnership with BOCES II and Roberts Wesleyan University. With her sights set on becoming a nurse, Maria is stepping boldly into her future.

Progress takes many forms. Sometimes it's found in a moment of connection, other times it's through formed partnerships, or striving towards your goals. Every day, we witness moments of progress that change lives in ways both big and small.
